The City has no plans to mill and pave the entire roadway. The intent is to ameliorate damage to both Stapp Drive & Edinburgh during construction. The contractor shall review and document the existing condition of the roadway before construction. Contractors are to bid this work based on the description in the bid schedule and specifications. Contractor will be paid for actual paving work completed as required for the project.
