	QUESTION	ANSWER
1	Does the City prefer Right of Way Plans, Right of Way Plats, or both?	Right of Way plans will be required for GDOT review. Individual Right of Way plats are required for City acquisition purposes.
2	Will Right of Way staking be required?	No.
3	Will the two intersections be considered as separate projects for permitting and construction?	Yes, these will be two separate plans sets.
4	On page 10 of the RFP, it states that the Prime Consultant or subconsultant MUST be prequalified by GDOT in these area classes: 3.02; 3.06; 3.07; and 3.09. Then it states that The Team (either the Prime Consultant and/or one or more of their sub-consultant team members) MUST be prequalified by GDOT in the additional area classes. Can you please confirm that all area classes listed can be fulfilled by both prime and subconsultant?	Areas 3.02, 3.06, 3.07, and 3.09 must be fulfilled by the prime consultant. The other areas may be fulfilled by either the prime or subconsultant.
5	Can firms include exceptions to the RFP Terms within the technical proposal?	Yes, exceptions may be considered.
6	Will the selected firm have the opportunity to negotiate final contract terms?	The City will send a contract to the winning firm. We will consider requests for amendments by the consultant.
7	Are we allowed to include more than three (3) case studies in our submittal?	Yes, but pages will count toward the 20-page limit.
8	Can you please confirm that Section 4. Pricing, on page 13 of the RFP, is to be submitted separately in the Cost Proposal?	That is correct.
