

WHAT ARE WE DOING?

Developing a resource to standardize City signage.

- Gateways, including a gateway arch for Downtown Trail
- Wayfinding
- Plaques
- City limit signs

- Park signage (kiosks, park rules, etc)
- Banner support structures
- Trail signage
- Artistic signage, and/or "selfie art"








WHAT ARE WE DOING?

Developing a resource to guide design decisions for public spaces.

- Benches
- Trash cans, recycling bins, dumpster enclosures, pet waste disposal
- Lighting
- Streetscape design & elements
- Street signposts
- Street name signs and sign toppers
- Bollards (material, colors, etc.)

- Center island design for roundabouts
- Crosswalks and ADA ramps standards
- Manhole cover designs
- MARTA bus shelters
- Landscaping
- Retaining wall and fence materials



WHAT ARE WE DOING?

Creating options for sustainable development that may include...

- Land use
- Transportation
- Materials management
- Energy
- Water



HOW ARE THESE IDEAS APPLIED?

- Only City signage will be impacted.
- Landscaping guidelines only apply to projects involving the public realm.
- Private spaces (yards, amenity centers, etc.) will not be required to use them, but developers and property owners are welcome to use them.

WHAT'S THE PROCESS?

INITIATE (COMPLETE)

- Initial consultation with City staff
- Pull inspiration imagery
- Develop initial concepts

CONSULT

(NOW - OCTOBER)

- Presentations at Mayor & Council meetings
- Meetings with the public
- Online survey

FINALIZE


(NOVEMBER - JANUARY)

- Incorporate feedback into signage design and other selections
- Final documents



ONLINE SURVEY

- Open from 7/17 to 8/22.
- 540 responses
- Highlights:
 - Theme 2 was overwhelmingly the favorite of the three themes.
 - Granite, wood, and black steel were preferred materials.

ONLINE SURVEY


- Highlights (con't):
 - "Branded" street furniture got mixed results—some things were strongly favored while others were voted the least favorite.
 - "Classic" options were more preferred.
 - Native plantings with colorful blooms are preferred.
 - Open-ended responses indicated a desire for lowmaintenance, inexpensive, and practical options for street furniture and landscaping

 - Gateway locations








POP-UP MEETING (8/2/24)


